### **AIRWAY CLEARANCE TECHNIQUES TRAINING COURSE**

This course will teach and consolidate knowledge of physiological and theoretical principles of airway clearance techniques with practical teaching and demonstrations. Suitable for any physiotherapists wishing to optimise airway clearance skills for patients with suppurative lung disease. This course is a pre-requisite to the PhySIIIG ACT instructors course.



### **THE CHALLENGES OF MANAGING THE NEUROPSYCHIATRIC AND PSYCHOLOGICAL EFFECTS OF MODULATORS: PRACTICAL AND CLINICAL IMPLICATIONS.**

Tuesday 3 June 14:00 - 18:00

Organised by the European Psychosocial Special Interest Group (EPSIG) and the ECFS Mental Health Working Group. We will explore how CF teams are managing the neuropsychiatric and psychological effects of modulators. This course will include a review of the evidence on side-effects related to new genetic modulators as well as strategies CF Teams are using to manage them. The course will include case presentations on the assessment of side effects and clinical interventions that have been used to address them. We will emphasize practical approaches to screening and intervention in this new era of modulator therapy. Cases will cover the life span from childhood through adulthood.

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### **CLINICAL NUTRITION COURSE: FROM KNOWLEDGE TO PRACTICE: SHAPING EFFECTIVE NUTRITION HABITS.**

This course provides healthcare professionals with a unique opportunity to engage with leading experts in the field of nutrition. ### ECFS Award

The ECFS Award is given annually to honour a person who has made an outstanding contribution to our basic understanding of cystic fibrosis or to the treatment or care of patients with cystic fibrosis. The winner of the award will be invited to present a lecture at the Opening Plenary on 04 June 2025 of the annual conference in Milan, Italy. The deadline for proposals is 14 March 2025. ### Gerd Döring Award

The Gerd Döring Award honors an outstanding early-career European scientist annually with a €5,000 research grant. It is awarded based on a significant paper published between 2022-2024, with CVs and personal statements contributing 20% to the evaluation. Eligible candidates are PhD students or postdocs with up to four years of research experience. Nominations from mentors, supervisors, and colleagues are encouraged. The submission deadline is 14 March 2025.
