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






Belgium (2021)

- Population: 11,59 Million
- 1379 people with CF
 - \rightarrow 65,8 % > 18 years
 - → 14 % transplanted




→ 33 new diagnoses, average age at diagnosis 4,4 months

Our CF-center in general

- Weekly multidisciplinary consultation
- Weekly multidisciplinary meeting
- Adults and pediatrics separated
- BUT at the age of 18 transition
- Both IV therapy at home and in the hospital
- At least 4 multidisciplinary consultations a year
- 1annual check-up



MY job at our CF-center

Coordination:

- → Smooth running of the multidisciplinary consultations (who is where, what still needs to be done?, ...)
- → Scheduling follow-up appointments /manage calendar
- → Follow-up consultation /results/ ill patients
- → Planning the annual check-up
- → Back-up in the absence of the doctor
- → Extra attention for transition!



MY job at our CF-center

- First point of contact for patient, family
- Reachable by phone
- Scheduling admission + Follow-up of hospitalized patients
- Further training / meetings



What kind of CF-nurse do i want to be?

- Being accessible
- Always available during the day
- Providing a place where patients feel comfortable
- Providing good care!
- Multidisciplinary work
- Good contacts with other services
- Being empathetic: laughing, crying, more serious conversations...



Extra attention for

- Prevention of cross-infections
- Organise a smooth multidisciplinairy follow-up
- Give evidence based care
- A good collaboration between pediatric and adult care/transition
