I would be honoured to serve as a board member of the European Cystic Fibrosis Society – it is a wonderful organisation that binds CF care together across Europe and I would love to contribute to its further success.

I have been working with people with cystic fibrosis since 1996 and as a consultant at Royal Papworth Hospital (Cambridge, UK) for over 20 years. During this period our patient numbers have increased from 150 to >400 adults, our consultant team has expanded from two to six members, we have incorporated academic medicine within our service and designed a state-of-the-art CF centre within our newly built hospital.

I have supported the European Cystic Fibrosis Society through being:

My research interests include the pathogenesis and treatment of CF related low bone mineral density; the management of non-tuberculous mycobacterial infection in CF; infection control (particularly the use of UV light disinfection and ventilation) in CF; as well as contributing to the international effort of conducting clinical trials of new medicines for people with cystic fibrosis.
