Innovation and Research Award (2025)

The winner of this award will receive a €500 grant. Proposal should include the following information:

- What is the innovation? e.g.: change in the care pathway during pediatric to adult transition; nurse follow-up after Trikafta introduction; developing mental health support.
- O What is its goal of your project?
- What steps have you taken or plan to take, and how will you implement your idea?
- o How has patient care improved?
- What challenges have you encountered and how have you addressed them?

The awardee will be invited to give a 15-minute presentation on their project or idea for improving patient care in the field of CF during the pre-conference nurse day.

The NSiG committee will review all proposals and reach out to you in early May 2025.
