We granted 3 Young Investigator Awards and were delighted to welcome the Young Investigator Awardees to the Closing Ceremony. We were also happy to support 20 young researchers with a Travel Grant.

Vienna is considered one of the most beautiful capitals in the world, a city of artists, traditions, waltzes and exquisite cuisine. Our Conference will be hosted at the Austria Center Vienna (ACV), which is Austria's largest conference centre. Close to the Danube River, the conference centre is ideally located; it only takes seven minutes by public transport to reach it from the city centre.

The abstract submission for the conference will open in December and will close on 13 January 2023.

The notifications for abstract acceptance will be sent mid-March 2023 and the deadline for early registration to the conference will be on 23 March 2023.



JCF - Increased Impact Factor

The Journal Impact Factor is an index that measures how often a journal's articles are cited in other research. In any given year, the impact factor of a journal is the number of citations, received in that year, of articles published in that journal during the two preceding years, divided by the total number of articles published in that journal during the two preceding years .

The European Cystic Fibrosis Society is pleased to announce that the official 2021 Impact Factors (IF) were recently released, and the Journal of Cystic Fibrosis (JCF) has increased its IF from 5.482 to 5.527. The JCF ranks 18th in the Respiratory System category.

The ECFS would like to thank the Editor in Chief, Dr. Patrick Flume, and the Editorial Board. Their excellent work has helped JCF gain its current standing and continues to aid its growth.



ECFS-CFE Post-Doctoral Research Fellowship

With aim to foster basic and translational research on cystic fibrosis, the ECFS and Cystic Fibrosis Europe (CFE), the federation of national CF associations in Europe, have joined forces to support a number of European Post-Doctoral 2-year duration Research Fellowships. We are happy to announce that three Post-doctoral Research fellowships have been awarded this year and we would like to extend our congratulations to Dr. Anna Esposito, Dr. Alessandra Murabito and Dr. Arianna Venturini, all three of them coming from Italy!

- Anna Esposito - University of Naples will work on:
Liposomal formulation of a novel dual acting agent with anti-inflammatory and anti-infective properties for cystic fibrosis lung disease treatment.
- Alessandra Murabito - University of Turin will work on:
Exploiting a PI3Ky mimetic peptide to restore CFTR localization at the plasma membrane
- Arianna Venturini - Telethon Institute of Genetics and Medicine, Naples will work on:
Identification of novel NMD modulators to rescue nonsense mutations in cystic fibrosis



ERS Award 2022

Each year the ERS present a number of prestigious awards to recognise the achievements of a select group of leaders in the field of respiratory medicine. These awards acknowledge scientific merit and engagement within the ERS by honouring exceptional members for their exemplary achievements and potential for further outstanding developments in all respiratory areas and within the society.

This year Prof. Pierre-Régis Burgel received the ERS Mid-career Gold medal in cystic fibrosis. Pierre-Régis Burgel is Professor of Respiratory Medicine at Université Paris Cité, France, where he is co-Principal Investigator in the Acute and Chronic Airway Infection Laboratory (Cochin Institute, INSERM, Paris France). Professor Burgel is a senior consultant at the Respiratory Medicine Department of Cochin Hospital in Paris and is the national coordinator of the French Cystic Fibrosis Reference Centre Network (47 CF centres). He is vice-president of the French Cystic Fibrosis Society and associate editor of The Journal of Cystic Fibrosis. He currently serves as a member of the Scientific Committee of the ECFS Patient Registry.
