CLINICAL NUTRITION COURSE:

CF NUTRITION GUIDELINES: WHAT SHOULD YOU KNOW? FROM EVIDENCE TO EVERYDAY PRACTICE.

(Limited Seating)

Tuesday 2 June 12:30 - 16:30

This pre-conference short course offers healthcare professionals an exceptional opportunity to learn directly from leading experts in CF nutrition. Held over a single afternoon, the programme is divided into two focused sessions.

The first session will provide an up-to-date overview of the latest CF nutrition guidelines—serving as an essential introduction for those new to CF care and a valuable refresher for more experienced clinicians.

The second session will explore emerging and evolving areas where current guidance is limited or still developing. Topics will include discontinuation of tube feeding, obesity, PERT management in changing pancreatic status and aging. Experts will share their perspectives, followed by structured discussion designed to encourage active participation and critical reflection.

Interactive components will be woven throughout the afternoon, creating space for attendees to exchange experiences, ask questions, and engage in practical, case-based dialogue—ensuring a collaborative and clinically relevant learning experience.

This one-day course will provide doctors working in resource-limited settings from Low- and Middle-Income Countries (LMICs) with the key skills and tools to optimise cystic fibrosis (CF) care. Participants will gain knowledge from international experts. Sessions will include practical hands-on training in basic airway-clearance techniques, along with skill building sessions covering practical strategies for nutritional management and essential psychological skills. Real-world clinical case examples will be utilised throughout the day to facilitate understanding, provide a platform for discussing specific challenges in care provision, and collaboratively explore actionable solutions.

ACCESS FACILITIES

PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION IN LISBON

Lisbon has a comprehensive public transportation network. Carris – Companhia Carris de Ferro de Lisboa operates the city's buses, trams, and funiculars.

Single ticket:	€ 1,85
Day ticket:	€ 7,00

You can buy tickets with a Viva Viagem or Navegante card, available at metro stations, Carris service points, and authorised retailers across the city. Ticket machines at metro stations accept coins, banknotes, and most credit or debit cards.

You can also use your contactless bank card directly on board: simply tap your card each time you travel, you can buy multiple tickets as well. The system automatically calculates the most convenient fare and charges it later, usually within a few days.

BIKE SHARING

Bikes are an eco-friendly and practical way to get around Lisbon. Although the city is known for its hills, it offers an expanding network of cycle paths and riverside routes that make cycling increasingly accessible and enjoyable.

Bike sharing is available through GIRA, the city's public bicycle network, which operates with fixed pickup and drop-off stations. You can use the GIRA app to unlock conventional or electric bikes and return them at any docking station across Lisbon.

ARRIVAL BY TRAIN

Lisbon can be reached from major Portuguese and European cities by train, operated by Comboios de Portugal (CP).

The main stations are:

- Santa Apolónia – long-distance and international services
- Oriente – main hub for high-speed Alfa Pendular and Intercidades trains, as well as suburban lines
- Entrecampos – suburban and intercity connections
- Sete Rios – regional and intercity services
