Summary of proposed work:

- To understand current experiences of CF telehealth practices for all stakeholders 1. in this space and benchmark against other lung diseases. This will be done through:
 - a. Stakeholder Questionnaires Currently collecting data.
 - b. Literature Reviews Review Registered and currently reviewing manuscripts.
 - c. And Public Patient Involvement Activities (PPI) 4 townhall meetings have been held with PwCF and their family/caregivers.
- To design frameworks for developing standards for future care of CF telehealth 2. and guidance on implementation. Ongoing – to begin in year 2/3.
- To develop educational materials that will support potential implementation of 3. the practices.

WP5 has now been established and have met twice.

Over the last year, the THCF have begun researching the various components needed to develop best practice guidelines for CF telehealth, this has been done through the 5 WPs. The group has achieved many of its milestones including engaging with PwCF to learn more, developing and releasing stakeholder surveys, and registering and beginning a systematic review. For this coming year, the group has many more aims and objectives which we confidently aspire to achieve, particularly through the new WPs established in 2025 (4 & 5).
