

Eddie Landau, PhD, is a consultant clinical and medical psychologist working at the Graub CF Center, Institute of Pulmonology at the Schneider Children's Medical Center (SCMC), Israel. Eddie's clinical activities involve a wide range of psychotherapeutic approaches and diagnostic work with children and adults with CF and their families. She is currently co-chair of the ECFS Mental Health Working Group.
