Aims/ Objectives:

At the end of the session, the participant will be able to:

- 1. Describe an overview of problematic (cognitive) processes in trauma and traumatic grief
- 2. Illustrate when insufficient grief elaboration leads to complicated grief
- 3. Produce a set of do's & dont's for caregivers
- 4. Explain the need for a better understanding of what influences mental health from a systemic and environmental perspective.
- 5. Point out the shared humanity that everybody has with one another, whether or not you have a chronic disease.
- 6. Describe the long term impact of trauma on families and health care providers: experiences from the clinic.
- 7. Describe Movement Desensitization and Reprocessing (EMDR) as one of the most important methods in the treatment of psychotrauma; recall the differences and possible applications for adults and children, and propose simple application possibilities in everyday life outside of psychotherapy.
