Background

- In March 1999 the CF-nurse and the dietician in the CF-center in Aarhus Denmark, took initiative to invite nurses and dietitians from the CF-centers in Sweden, Norway and Denmark to a meeting. Later on Iceland was invited.
- Together formed the nurses this group, inspired of the International Group – INSG/CF.



- The group consists of one nurse and a deputy from each CF-center.
 We call ourselves the Network.
 (In Scandinavia there are also networks of doctors and other)
 - (In Scandinavia there are also networks of doctors and other paramedical staff working with CF).
- Meetings twice a year and between that, we have e-mail contact.

Aim

- Increase collaboration between the Scandinavian CF-nurses.
- Share experiences, knowledges and give education to colleagues working with CF.



This we have done so far...

- Every other year the SNSG-group arrange a "Work-shop" during 2 days. We invite nurses, from Scandinavia and Iceland, working with CF.
- Projects together / Quality work: for example "Home i.v.-treatment".
 - Questionnaries was sent to colleagues in our countries. We found: similarities, differences, things we could improve.
 - A second questionnarie was sent to children/parents and adult patients. The results from this survey is not completed yet.
- Posterpresentations.

And this is for the future...

- In the beginning we arranged, together with Gothenburg University, an education (medical and psychosocial program). Can this happen again?
- There was also wishes and thoughts of a common database and a website were we could write about what happened in the SNSG/CFgroup.
