

PROF. TIDDENS

Harm Tiddens is a Professor in pediatric pulmonology at the ErasmusMC-Sophia Children's Hospital and at the department of radiology.

He is heading the research of the Sophia Cystic Fibrosis (CF)-center and of the ErasmusMC Lung Imaging Group (ELIG) focussing on the development of novel structure and function outcome measures and computational model systems to study chronic lung diseases. In 1997 he co-founded the European CF Society Clinical Trial Network (ECFS-CTN) that currently includes participation of over 17.500 CF patients and 43 CF centers. He was deputy chair of the ECFS-CTS executive committee, liaison between ECFS-CTN and TDN and was the primary reviewer of one of the protocol review committees. He founded and is heading the ErasmusMC core laboratory 'LungAnalysis'.

He is a visiting professor at the Princess Margaret Hospital for Children in Perth. He is editorial board member for *Pediatric Pulmonology* and regular reviewer for all major respiratory journals and for many funding bodies. He has been co-initiator and co-organiser of the ERS-ECFS basic and advanced CF courses. He published over 180 papers in peer reviewed journals and contributed chapters to over 40 books.
